Article 1:

Article 2:

Article 3:

Procedure are a passion at Juba in all our operations, that is documentation, responses to incidents such as fire, etc.

Article 10:

Human resource through specialization and expertise is healthy to our business hence our commitment to promoting good health through HIV and AIDS programmes e.g. condom distribution. However we encourage abstinence at all times.

Avoid contamination at all costs. Pay attention to hazards and respect all rules.
